NDC MEMBERSHIP STATS

- With over 90 Members, the NDC will remain the largest House Democratic ideological caucus, meaning the center of gravity within the Democratic Party is moderate.
- The NDC makes up over 40 percent of the House Democratic Caucus and holds a similar percentage of seats on many key committees.
- The NDC was the only House ideological caucus to flip seats from Red to Blue in 2020.
- As of Dec. 1st, 22 Frontliner races have been called in the NDC's favor, helping the Democratic Caucus maintain the House majority.
- 80 percent of the Coalition's membership today either took a Republican-held seat or replaced a sitting New Dem.
